

HOW CAN YOU PARTICIPATE AS A EXECUTIVE VOLUNTEER IN I.N.D.I.A TRUST

AS A YOUTH

- You can form a I.N.D.I.A TRUST cell that will discuss the states of Leadership education in the country and whether it enables the youth to be effective citizens in the present-day context. This cell will follow-up with I.N.D. I.A. TRUST activities in your school/college/university/institution and interact with the I.N.D.I.A. co-ordination unit.
- You can initiate an association with government/other schools to your school/college/university by facilitating/organizing
- You can share information about I.N.D.I.A. TRUST with friends in other colleges and facilities in the formation of a I.N.D.I.A. TRUST cell in their school/college/university/institution.
- You can also contribute your time in the preparation and sourcing of materials for children to be utilized by your I.N.D.I.A. TRUST cell for various activities. This material could also be made available for activities or programmes in other school/college/university/institution.
- Support school/college/university/institution in conducting research for curriculum development or in the assessment of learning levels.
- You can start a LDC (Leadership Development Center) in your living area which will function as education centers for sports, craft, cultural activities etc for children in your locality. This will also serve as a center for children to discuss issues relating to their school/college/university, their role in the neighborhood and as citizens. The I.N.D.I.A. TRUST co-ordination unit will support you in the setting up of these centers.
- You can conduct supplementary/literacy classes for a group of women/children/youth in your area and broaden the scope of such interactions to discuss their role in I.N.D.I.A. TRUST.

AS A TEACHER

- You can initiate a discussion about I.N.D.I.A. TRUST with you colleagues who share your concern about present day elementary education.
- You can be part of a research effort to study specific issues in education, related to curriculum development, joyful learning levels, educational administration and planning are any other aspect which can contribute to building a developmental approach to education.
- You can enable children to relate their learning to day-to-day life to make education more relevant in the larger context so that it can be included in the progress of regular teaching.
- You can create a forum for children to express themselves with regard to various aspects of learning like the curriculum, method of learning they would prefer, other activities which they can do in school/college/university/institution.
- You can start a LDC (Leadership Development Center) in your school/college/university/institution, or its neighborhood, are the area in which you live, by raising local resources with the support of I.N.D.I.A. TRUST co-ordination unit by interacting and sharing your experiences on elementary education.
- You can also work with the I.N.D.I.A. TRUST co-ordination unit in the preparation of communication and resource materials when required.
- You can create opportunities to facilitate parent's participation in the effective functioning of schools by encouraging them to take more interest in school/college/university/institution development activities.
- You can conduct literacy classes for a group of women/children/youth in your area and broaden the scope of such interactions to engage them in I.N.D.I.A. TRUST.
- You can take active part in SBCs (School Betterment Committees)/VECs (Village Education Committees), activities in your child's school/college/university/institution by facilitating a development role (not based on charity) for such committees.
- You can organize programmes at regular intervals, for children in your school/college/university/ Institution, to impart information about information about issues, skill, art, culture, craft etc and share the same, which will be documented in the I.N.D.I.A TRUST resource center.

AS A PARENT

- You can share information about this initiative with like-minded parents who are concerned about issues related to present-day education.
- You can take active part in the school/college/university/institution Betterment Committees/Village Education Committees of your child or any school in your locality.

- You can build an interaction with the school/college/university/institution in your area contributing your time for programmes conducted by the school/college/university/institution whether cultural, development sports etc.
- You can initiate the formation of a I.N.D.I.A. TRUST parents' cell in your neighbourhood to discuss and respond to issues arising in your neighbourhood school/college/university/institution.
- You can initiate a Leadership Development Centre in your locality or contribute resource material for the same. You can also participate in I.N.D.I.A. TRUST by visiting such centres regularly or also by volunteering to manage the centre. Here you can conduct activities for children through craft, story-telling, songs, dance, painting, games, sport etc. The I.N.D.I.A. TRUST co-ordination unit will help you initiate such a centre.
- You can contribute time, resources, expertise during processes organized by I.N.D.I.A. TRUST at the ward/village/taulka or district level.
- You can initiate a process with your municipal councilors/Gram panchayat to pay attention to the various aspects of schooling and related matters in their respective wards/village.
- You can conduct literacy class for a group of women/children/youth in your area and broaden the scope of such interactions to discuss I.N.D.I.A. TRUST.
- You can be part of a research effort to study specific issues in education, related to curriculum development, joyful learning assessment of learning levels of educational administration and planning or any other aspect which can contribute to building a development approach to education.
